

Adult Supervision Policy

Tee-Aire Golf is committed to providing a safe and comfortable environment for all customers, visitors and staff. We require that guests under the age of 16 be accompanied at all times by a parent or supervising adult (ages 18+) while on Tee-Aire Golf property. Unaccompanied youths (under age 16) will not be permitted.

- Proof of age may be required for the youth on-site. Those who lack proper identification may be asked to leave the property. Valid identification includes a state issued driver's license or ID card, a military ID, or a passport. The identification must be tamper proof and include a photograph and date of birth.
- One adult (ages 18+) may accompany up to six youths. All accompanied youths must remain with the supervising adult at all times.
- All guests must have transportation off of the property, that is immediately available, in the event of an inclement weather closure, business closure or emergency.
- Supervising adults (ages 18+) are responsible for the actions of the youth they accompany.

Code of Conduct

Tee-Aire Golf takes pride in the quality of its golf facilities. This Code of Conduct is intended to ensure a safe, respectful, and family-friendly environment for customers and staff.

This Code of Conduct gives examples of acceptable and unacceptable behavior. This is not an all-inclusive list. Please note that the privilege of any individual to utilize Tee-Aire Golf facilities may be denied, suspended or terminated at the discretion of Tee-Aire Golf.

Any individual or party whose conduct is deemed disruptive, unsafe, disrespectful or creates any other disturbance or damage will be asked to leave the property immediately by staff. Said individual or party may also be subject to additional fees, administrative or legal action.

All Tee-Aire Golf guests are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that:

- Creates an environment of safety, honesty, integrity, and good sportsmanship.
 This is required whether on the driving range, miniature golf course, in the clubhouse or present on any other portion of the property.
- Is free of discrimination or any form of harassing behavior to fellow guests or staff.

- Recognizes that Tee-Aire Golf is a family-friendly environment. All guests must wear appropriate attire at all times, refrain from using obscenities or excessively loud and otherwise inappropriate behavior.
- Shows respect to fellow guests and staff.
- Complies with all posted facility rules and instructions/requests from Tee-Aire staff.
- Is vigilant in reporting real or perceived safety concerns to staff or management.
- Does not talk down to, ridicule, or raise your voice at fellow guests or staff members.
- Does not interfere with the ability of guests or staff to use the clubhouse, driving range, and miniature golf course for its intended purpose.
- Acknowledges that alcoholic beverages and glass containers are not permitted on the property. All food and drinks must be enjoyed in designated areas. All spills must be reported to staff immediately.
- Acknowledges that pets and emotional support animals are not granted public accommodation or access to Tee-Aire Golf property or golf facilities.
- Acknowledges that there are equipment facilities, structures, and residences on the Tee-Aire Golf property. Guests of Tee-Aire Golf do not have access to any location on the property other than the clubhouse, driving range, putting/chipping green, miniature golf course or guest parking lot.

Any guest who violates or fails to observe the Tee-Aire Golf Code of Conduct may be:

- Issued a verbal warning or written warning.
- Temporarily banned from the property for a defined period of time, at the discretion of Tee-Aire Golf staff.
- Permanently banned from the property.
- Removed from the property without refund.
- Held monetarily responsible for damage to property.
- Subject to forfeiture of any fees paid in advance.

While visiting Tee-Aire Golf, the following general activities will not be accepted, this is not an all-inclusive list:

- Violations of the law.
- Any activity that threatens the safety of guests or staff.
- Any activity that threatens the well-being of the property.
- Any activity that disrupts the family-friendly environment.
- Any activity that does not meet the general purpose of the property.
- Any activity that disrupts the legitimate business of the property.
- Failure to follow posted rules and instructions/requests from Tee-Aire staff.
- Trespassing on Tee-Aire property when business is closed.
- Firearms or illegal weapons are not permitted on the property.

All Tee-Aire Golf guests are required to act responsibly and follow posted property rules and the Code of Conduct. Failure to do so will result in being asked to leave the property. Refusal to leave the property may result in law enforcement involvement and criminal charges.
